There will be no contact obstacle familiarization at this trial, but there will be a practice jump. Handlers will walk the course without dogs.

Entry Fee

\$26 for first entry per dog per day (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee); \$13 for each additional entry per same dog per same day (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee). A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

Directions to Show Site

If you are using a GPS, please use the address 1000 West Park Avenue, Niles, OH 44446.

<u>From South:</u> Take I-77 or I-71 N toward Cleveland. Exit onto I-76 East toward Akron. Take I-80 toward Youngstown and NYC. Exit on Route 46 North toward Niles. See "All" below.

<u>From East or West:</u> Take Turnpike and exit at interchange 218. Take I-80 East to Route 46 North toward Niles. See "All" below.

From North: Take 11 South to I-80 West. Exit on Route 46 North. See "All" below.

<u>All:</u> Go north on 46 for about 5 miles into Niles, where 46 becomes North Main Street. Turn left onto Park Avenue. (If you reach E. Church Street, you've gone a little too far.) Crating

Vendors

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION Don Farage is a VMO

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, then ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. Exhibitors should have jump height cards to present if requested.

Show Conditions and Timers: .

100' by 100' rings that are indoors on professional turf with sand base, rubber pellets, and no obstructions. Contacts have a rubberized surface. The site is air conditioned and kept in the upper 60s. Electronic Timers will be used in these trials.

Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place qualifying dogs in each class and height division. Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. MACH/PACH bars and MACH/PACH rosettes will be awarded for all MACH/PACH titles earned at this show. New title ribbons will be awarded to those earning a title at the trials.

Wait List •

If entry limits are reached prior to closing, YABTC will offer a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 200 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to event closing on November 18, 2016. Any entries withdrawn by 6:00 pm November 25, 2016 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry by November 25, 2016 a full refund will be issued.

Liability:

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Youngstown All-Breed Training Club and its agents, employees, volunteers, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by any exhibitor or handler or to their dog(s) or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

AKC Clothing Policy

Advertising is not allowed in the AKC agility ring on the clothing worn by an exhibitor or ring crew staff, such as, "train at Joe's Dog School," or "eat at Joe's Diner." Club shirts may be worn. Writing on clothing must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. Clothing must not display the name of a person or a person's dog or their titles. If a dog food logo is worn, it must not be in conflict with a sponsor of the trial. A picture of the exhibitor's dog may be worn.

Dogs Eligible to Enter •

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect their physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to insure that their dogs are free from internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases, and that their dogs have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of rabies vaccination should be available.
