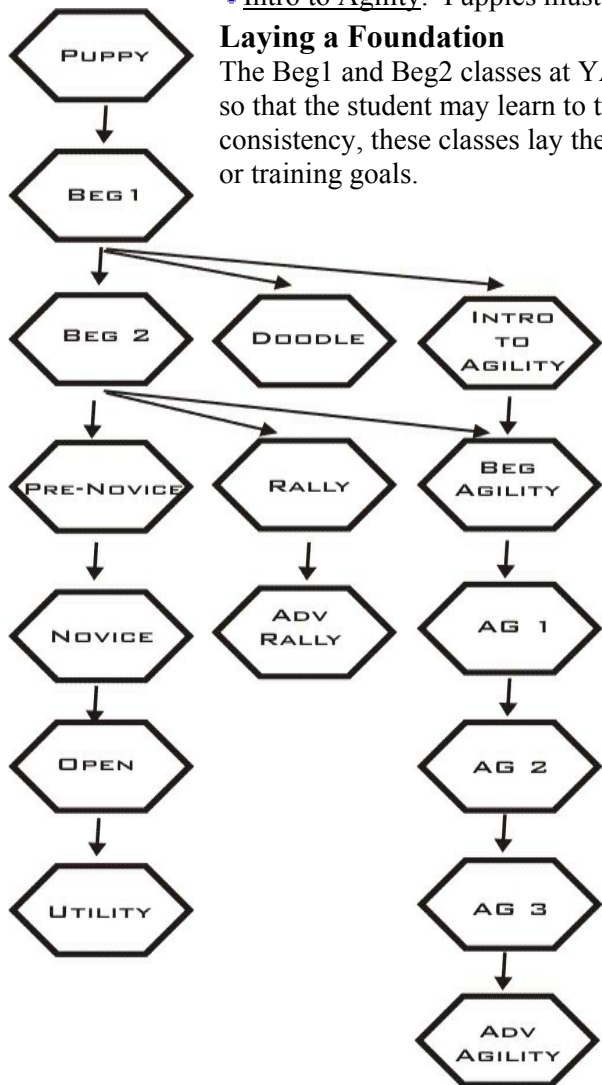

Age Rules

- ◆ Puppies must be over 10 weeks to enter the YABTC building.
- ◆ Beg1 is a starting point for any puppy who has taken Puppy class, or any dog over 6 months
- ◆ Intro to Agility: Puppies must be over 9 months.

Laying a Foundation

The Beg1 and Beg2 classes at YABTC instruct the student on many proven methods of obedience training, so that the student may learn to train his dog basic household obedience skills. With practice and consistency, these classes lay the foundation and provide the gateway for any and all future classes, activities or training goals.



After Beg1 *

- ◆ After a student has taken Beg1, he may take Beg2, Doodle, and/or Intro to Agility.

After Beg2 (CGC test on Last day of class)*

- ◆ After a student has taken Beg2, he may take Pre-Novice, Rally, AG1 (after success in Intro to Agility).

Membership

- ◆ After a student has taken 2 classes, he is eligible to apply for membership. YABTC offers single and family memberships. Applications are available in the hallway near the office. After you have completed your application, please have 2 people, who have been members for at least one year, sign your form as sponsors. Place your application and a dues check made out to YABTC, into an envelope. Give your envelope to any member, who will ensure it is given to a Board member, or you may mail your envelope to the Club.
- ◆ Your application will be reviewed by the Board at its next meeting, and if approved, you will be asked to attend the next scheduled general meeting, where the members in attendance will be presented with your request to join the club, and then asked to vote on your acceptance.
- ◆ Once you have become a member, there are many entry level classes discounted by 50%, and many advanced level courses that you may take at no charge.

*Class availability or selection may vary. Your instructor can help point you in a direction that is right for you and your dog. Class descriptions are on the back of this page. Schedules are available in the hallway across from the office or online at YABTC.com

Agility

Intro to Agility 8 weeks \$90

Gently introduces the dogs and handlers to each of the obstacles used in AKC agility. Dogs progress at their own rate. All dogs are worked on lead until they can demonstrate control. Food treats and toys are required. Completion of beginner obedience is recommended.

Agility 1 8 Weeks \$90

Dogs begin working obstacle sequences off lead. Dog and handler teams are introduced to basic agility turns. Most dog/handler teams take this class at least twice. *The second time the dog is enrolled, it is no charge.*

Prerequisite: Intro Agility
Recommended: Beg2 Obedience

Agility 3 8 Weeks \$90

Advanced agility turns and complex exercises are taught with the assumption that teams are preparing for competition.

Prerequisite: Agility 2
Recommended: Beg2 Obedience

Beginner Agility 8 Weeks \$50

Continuation of Intro to Agility. Dogs will further master obstacles previously introduced.

Agility 2 8 weeks \$50

This "off Lead" class concentrates on improving handling. The dog must know all the obstacles, including weave poles from both sides to take this class.

Prerequisite: Agility 1
Recommended: Beg2 Obedience

Adv. Agility 8 Weeks \$90

Competition level class of agility. Teams in this class hold a title from one of the agility venues (if CPE, Level 2 or higher) These classes are offered free to YABTC members whose dogs have reached this level of their agility training.

Obedience

Puppy 6 weeks \$70

Puppies must be a minimum of ten weeks to begin this class, and have their first two shot series.

Beginner 1 8 Weeks \$90

The eight week course will consist of one hour sessions each week, during which time the handler and dog will be taught basic obedience commands. Training collars are included in the class fee.

Doodle 6 Weeks \$70

Doodle is for the young dog that has finished puppy or beginner's one and is either getting ready for competition or just is not mature enough for the CGC test. We will be working on stays, recalls and heeling with attention. Class will be very positive and should be a lot of fun.

Prerequisite: Over 6 months of age, or completed puppy, or with permission of instructor

Beginner 2 8 Weeks \$90

The focus of Beg2 is geared towards instructing participants the components of the Canine Good Citizen (CGC) test, which is given the last day of class.

The CGC test can also be given for non-class member for a nominal fee. Contact the YABTC registrar for more information.

Prerequisite Beginner 1, (Beg1) or equivalent.

Competition 8 Weeks \$90

YABTC also offers Pre-Novice, Novice, Open and Utility training. These classes are held weekly all year, with the exception of the last 3 weeks of December. The competition level classes are offered at no charge to YABTC members.

Rally

Rally 6 Weeks \$90

Rally class does not teach obedience. It uses the obedience skills learned in previous classes to introduce students to the 50 AKC rally signs that are used in a course. The concentration of this course is on the Novice signs

Prerequisite: CGC Certificate or permission of Training Director

Advanced Rally 6 Weeks \$90

Rally class does not teach obedience. It uses the obedience skills learned in previous classes to introduce students to the 50 AKC rally signs that are used in a course. This class concentrates on the advanced & Excellent signs.

Prerequisite: Completion of 1st Rally class or permission of Training Director
