Make check payable to YOUNGSTOWN ALL BREED TRAINING CLUB INC. (Y.A.B.T.C.). Canadian exhibitors must have fees payable in US Funds Visa, Mastercard & Discover Card accepted with a \$3.00 fee per each use.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
