Wait List

If entry limits are reached prior to closing, YABTC will offer a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 60 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to event closing (5 p.m. Aug. 3). Any entries withdrawn by 6:00 pm on Monday, Aug. 6th, will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on Monday, Aug.6th will receive a full refund.

Entry Fee \$26 for first entry per dog per day (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee); \$12 second entry per dog per day (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee). A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

Directions to Show Site

If you are using a GPS, please use the address 1000 West Park Avenue, Niles, OH 44446.

From South: Take I-77 or I-71 N toward Cleveland. Exit onto I-76 East toward Akron. Take I-80 toward Youngstown and NYC. Exit on Route 46 North toward Niles. See "All" below.

From West: Take I-80 East to Route 46 North toward Niles. Exit at interchange 218. See "All" below.

From East: Take I-76 west toward Ohio. Exit at I-80 west. Exit on Route 46 North toward Niles. See "All" below.

From North: 11 South to I-80 west. Exit on Route 46 North. See "All" below.

All: Go north on 46 for about 5 miles into Niles, where 46 becomes North Main Street. Turn left on Park Avenue. (If you reach E. Church Street you've gone a little too far.) In less than a mile, turn right into Waddell Park. The park entrance is just past Highland Avenue. (If you reach Parkway Drive, you've gone .6 miles too far.) The Wellness Center will be on your right.

Crating

There is plenty of crating space, but we ask that you consolidate your set up as much as possible. X-pens should be set up so that they take no more space than the equivalent size that each dog's crate space would have consumed. Place ground covers/mats/tarps under the crates.

Measuring Dogs will be measured between classes. MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. **Exhibitors should have jump height cards to present if requested.**

Running Order

4-26" each day. In each jump height, B dogs will run first, followed by A dogs, followed by Preferred dogs unless conflicts change the running order.

Saturday: Ring 1: Excellent Standard, Open Standard, Novice Standard, Novice FAST. Runs begin at 8 a.m.

Ring 2: Novice JWW, Open JWW, Excellent JWW, Open FAST, Excellent FAST. Runs begin at 8:30 a.m.

Sunday: Ring 1 STD: Excellent, Open, Novice. Begins at 8 a.m.

Ring 2 JWW: Novice, Open, Excellent. Begins at 8:30 a.m.

Show Conditions: Indoors on soccer flooring in 100' by 100' rings. Contacts have a rubberized surface. The site is air conditioned. View photos of the site at www.yabtc.com. Click on event calendar and August trial.

Course Familiarization: There will be no contact obstacle familiarization at this trial. Handlers will walk the course without dogs.

Electronic Timers will be used in these trials.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place qualifying dogs in each class and height division. Flat qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. MACH/PACH bars and MACH/PACH rosettes will be awarded for all MACH/PACH titles earned at this show. PAX bars and PAX rosettes will be awarded for all PAX titles earned at this show. New title ribbons will be awarded to those earning a title at the trials.

Liability:

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Youngstown All-Breed Training Club and its agents, employees, volunteers, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

AKC Clothing Policy

Advertising is not allowed in the AKC agility ring on the clothing worn by an exhibitor or ring crew staff, such as, "train at Joe's Dog School," or "eat at Joe's Diner." Club shirts may be worn. Writing on clothing must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. Clothing must not display the name of a person or a person's dog or their titles. If a dog food logo is worn, it must not be in conflict with a sponsor of the trial. A picture of the exhibitor's dog may be worn.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect their physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of rabies vaccination should be available.

Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season and injured dogs will be awarded a refund (with Veterinary Certificate).

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
