requirements for the title by participating in a community walk/run and also documented walks. They completed the Strut Your Mutt Walk to benefit the



Mystery Dog Illness from "The Dog Food Advisor"

You may have read about the potentially fatal respiratory illness that's affected dogs across the country in recent weeks. Well, it's now spread to at least 14 states. They are:

- California
- Colorado
- Florida
- Georgia
- Idaho
- Illinois
- Indiana
- Maryland
- Massachusetts
- New Hampshire
- Oregon
- Rhode Island
- Vermont
- Washington

I don't want to cause panic but awareness of the illness can only be a good thing. That's why I've put together this story that lists the signs and symptoms and the current advice for dog parents: Mystery Dog Illness: What Is It And What Should I Do?

This tells you what signs to look for and what precautions you can take. I'm not a vet or an epidemiologist, so this article is just a summary of what experts have said. Things could change in the time it takes for you to read this email, so try to stay on top of the news.

As the word 'mystery' tells you, little is known for certain about the cause of the illness. However, it seems to be transmissible between dogs so there is a worry of it spreading further — thus the main piece of guidance is to avoid your dog mixing with other dogs where possible.

If you have any worries about your dog, please contact your vet. And please forward this email to any dog parents you know.

KANSAS STATE VETERINARY DIAGNOSTIC LABORATORY

Mysterious Canine Respiratory Disease

To help determine the associated pathogen(s) involved in the canine respiratory. disease circulating in some areas of the U.S., KSVDL is offering free Next Generation Sequencing testing through December 31st, 2023.

Submissions eligible for free testing can originate from veterinary practitioner submissions only and from cases where the practitioner suspects this new respiratory disease is involved.

Suitable samples:

- . (5 gm) Tissue (Lung, Lymph node or Tonsil)
- Swabs (Nasal or Pharyngeal)
- . Washes (Tracheal or BAL)

A gel bacterial swab is not acceptable. Cotton tipped and/or wooden shaft swabs are not acceptable.

The report from KSVDL identifies the organism(s) found in the sample. These may or may not be the causative organism(s) associated with this case.

Clients must ask for MDL-0202 to participate in this offer.


