Loyal Stay Dog Study LOY-002

I took a chance and decided to enroll my 11 year old Australian Shepherd, Gypsy, in the Loyal Stay Study for the drug LOY-002. Gypsy has played agility for a long time but is now retired. She ran in competition as Dipsy Doo. She is almost 12.



The Loyal Stay Dog Study is conducted by Loyal, a biotechnology company based in San Francisco, dedicated to extending the healthy lifespan of dogs. Loyal focuses on developing therapeutics aimed at improving the quality of life and longevity of dogs by targeting the biological mechanisms of aging.

LOY-002 is intended for dogs aged 10 or older and weighing at least 14 lb. It aims to extend healthy lifespan by targeting age-associated metabolic dysfunction.

As dogs age their metabolic health declines, leading to disease and reduced lifespan. The aim with LOY-002 is to preserve metabolic health, which they believe will delay the onset of age-associated disease and help maintain better function and quality of life.

Loyal has launched a double-blinded, placebocontrolled efficacy study recruiting 1,000 senior dogs in partnership with 55 veterinary clinics across the country.



Requirements to Join:

- 1. Age: Dogs must be at least 10 years old.
- 2. Size: Dogs must weigh at least 14 pounds.
- 3. **Health:** Dogs must be generally healthy but showing signs of aging.
- 4. **Breeds:** Open to all breeds, including mixed breeds, but exact age must be provable.
- 5. **Commitment:** Owners must be willing to commit to the duration of the study (4 yrs), which includes regular visits to the veterinarian and adherence to the study protocol.

In the Loyal Stay Dog Study, 50% of the participating dogs will receive a placebo instead of the active therapeutic. This double blind, placebo controlled study ensures the scientific validity and helps accurately assess the treatment's effectiveness.

In Gypsy's case, first, we looked for the nearest facility accepting new patients. The Loyal website has an interactive map of the USA showing the locations. We located the "Animal Hospital of Dauphin County (AHDC)" in Harrisburg, PA and gave them a call. The Vet clinic asked if we had Gypsy's vet records, and also, for proof of age, her AKC registration papers and breeding litter record. I already had an electronic copy of all her vet records to date because she is also enrolled in the "Dog Aging project". So, I sent the Clinic her records.

Next, I received a phone call from the Vet Clinic notifying me the paperwork was in order and the next step was to schedule a visit for a blood draw, urine sample and overall wellness check.

I made the appointment and away we went. At the Clinic, they went over the study details and I completed an electronic questionnaire about Gypsy with questions related to her health, lifestyle, pain level, activity level, mental state, with scales from 1-10.

While I completed the questionnaire, Dr. Coby Rudakewiz took Gypsy into another room and completed her exam. When they reentered the room, Dr. Coby let me know Gypsy was in good health but would not know if she was accepted into the study until the results of the bloodwork.

A couple days later, I received a phone call the bloodwork was normal and she was accepted into the study. A bottle of drugs (or Placebo) was delivered to my house a day later. The pill is a once a day chewable, given with food. Gypsy started treatment on May 29, 2024. Her next step is to go for additional blood work in a month.

So your next questions is..... Do I see a difference after a month? Well I'm not sure.... I still run her in agility but at a lower height for exercise. I try to run her once a week. She also loves to play a lot with my puppy. The hot (90+ degree) weather is hard on her and she rest a lot in the a/c. She is very social with my other dogs but avoids rough play. She used to always pace at the door to go to class with me but maybe the past 4 months she has not, and was happy to stay home.

She is pacing at the door again to go..... I really don't know. I did get a copy of her bloodwork results for my records and there was no cost for anything.

Next visit, Floyd and I are stopping at the Sight and Sound Theatre in Lancaster. We found a hotel where you can leave your dogs in the room while you attend the show.

I'll try to keep you updated on Gypsy's status. If you have any questions, let me know.








GCH CH Harper's The Phantom Tobias OA OAJ OF SWNE SWA

JULY PICNIC INFORMATION


